Intro

Chords: G⁵, B^b5, F⁵, G⁵

Techniques: slide

Riff

Fret numbers: 3 5 3 5 3 5 | 3 1 3 1 3 | 3 5 3 5 3 5 | 3 1 3 1

Verse/Chorus

Chords: G⁵, B^b, F², G⁵, F²

Techniques: slide

(move 3rd & 4th fingers up to 6th fret)

(actually, the whole song can be played with this shape !)

play verse progression 5 times

repeat Riff

end on G⁵

Handy hints

Always A Winner is based on a chord-riff that repeats throughout the song and also features chord sliding. To slide a chord take a little more pressure than just holding it but don't press too hard! Think of it as 'pushing the sound up the strings' - and remember the slide must be in time, like any strummed chord.
