Handy hints

Three-string power-chords give a stronger tone; professionals favour these forms. In the chorus, use the index finger flat on two strings for A⁵ and E⁵. *Back In Black* is a great example of Rock rhythm work: lots of short, strong-attack chords with rests in between. Count the rhythm slowly whilst learning - the chorus features syncopated rhythm typical of heavy Rock.
