Having trouble with bar-chords & reading strumming patterns?

Good Night is based on a repeating bar-chord pattern and the rhythm features 'percussive strums'. This is not an easy chart for beginners but you could make it a little easier by using a Capo at the 3rd fret. This will allow you to avoid the G and C bar-forms but you still need the D and Em bar-forms. To play whole songs with bar-chords you need good finger & wrist strength and if you've been playing less than 1 year you are probably still developing this. To learn more about bar-chords and rhythm reading, open-position chords and chord-change tricks, check out ***Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 1***.

If you are established and need to learn more about moving bar-chords along the fretboard, and how to create concise Rock rhythms, then use ***Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 2*** - it's got heaps of insightful info, exercises and progressions and an excellent accompanying CD to help you advance your skills.
