Bar-chords causing grief ? (hey, you're not the only one!)

You could use open-position Dm, C, Am but you will still need to play a bar-chord for the Bb: some songs can not be played properly without some bar-chord forms. If they hurt your hand just practice them for a few minutes at a time. It takes quite a lot of work to build up bar-chords if you are new to them. The rhythm for *Jona Vark* is created by playing constant down & up alternating strums: the strumming is shown. To learn more rhythm guitar techniques, including how to read strumming patterns, check out *Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 1* and *Volume 2* - excellent chord and rhythm style books.
