Chords

The chord diagrams show the following fingerings:

- A:** x02221 (x on 1st string, 0 on 2nd, 2 on 3rd, 2 on 4th, 2 on 5th, 1 on 6th)
- G:** 320003 (3 on 3rd, 2 on 4th, 0 on 5th, 0 on 6th)
- D:** x02321 (x on 1st string, 0 on 2nd, 2 on 3rd, 3 on 4th, 2 on 5th, 1 on 6th)
- E:** 022100 (0 on 1st, 2 on 2nd, 2 on 3rd, 1 on 4th, 0 on 5th, 0 on 6th)

Intro riff: play 3 times

The intro riff is in 4/4 time. The guitar tablature is as follows:

Verses (& intro)

Measures 4-6: A (with tied strums), V, V, A. Measure 7: G. Measure 8: D. Measure 9: etc.

Chorus

Measures 4-6: G (with tied strums), V, V, G. Measure 7: A. Measure 8: D. Measure 9: G. Measure 10: etc.

Ending

Measures 5-7: A (with tied strums), V, V, A. Measure 8: G. Measure 9: E. Measure 10: etc.

Having trouble getting the chords & rhythm together?
 All the chords used in You And Your Heart are introduced in *Modern Guitar Chord Styles I* from pages 8 to 17. Tied strums and common strumming patterns are introduced on pages 21 -23. More advanced patterns that use sixteenth-note strums are introduced on 31 -33. These pages have heaps of info on rhythm and chord changing techniques and all the practice samples are nice and clear on the accompanying play-along CD.
